

## **STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT 2018**

## Enrollment

3,660 students enrolled in credit courses at NGTC during Academic Year 2018. This was the Full Time Equivalent (FTE) of 1,820 students (based on the sum of total credit hours for all students).

The college's Student Retention Rate is 67% (based on first-time, regular admitted students enrolled in Fall 2016, who graduated or were still enrolled in a Georgia technical college or university system college as of the end of the next year, Academic Year 2018).

35.1% of students attended college full time, and 64.9% attended part time (based on fall semester 2017).
